

“UA Combine Competition”
Official Rules

1. GENERAL

- 1.1. Based on the country in which you have registered for and are participating in the UA Combine Competition 2022 (the “**Competition**”), the Competition is organized by the following Under Armour entities for the respective location (each, “**UA Sports**”):

- 1.2. 1.2. In these Rules, “**we**”, “**us**” and “**our**” refer to relevant UA Sports entity identified in paragraph 1 above and with whom you are contracting. “**You**” and “**your**” refer to any person who:

- 1.2.1. is participating in the Competition; and/or
1.2.2. registered for the Competition.

- 1.3. Country-specific terms may apply at Annex A to these Rules. In the event of any conflict and/or inconsistency between the body of the terms and Annex A, the terms set out in Annex A shall prevail.

- 1.4. The Competition will be held from 20/08/2022 to 17/09/2022. You will enjoy various programme and activities that we may offer to you in the lead-up to the Competition. The Competition will be held at the following locations and at the period indicated below:-

1.4.4.	Australia (Sydney)	17/09/2022, 1500 [Australian Eastern Standard Time (GMT +10)] and ends 17/09/2022, 2100 [Australian Eastern Standard Time (GMT +10)]

- 1.5. By registering for or participating in the Competition, you acknowledge and agree that you have read these Official Rules, and agree to be bound by, adhere to and comply with the terms of these Official Rules, as may be varied, amended or modified from time to time, and made available at: www.uacombineasia.com. To the maximum extent permitted under applicable law, We reserve the right to vary, amend or modify these Official Rules, at any time, in our sole and absolute discretion with as much notice to you as reasonably practicable.

- 1.6. To the maximum extent permitted under applicable law, we reserve the right to withdraw, discontinue, postpone or terminate the Competition with as much notice as reasonably practicable. We may also cancel or change the date and venue of the Competition with as much notice to you as reasonably practicable. We shall not be liable for any loss, damage or expenses incurred as a result.
- 1.7. If you breach (or are reasonably suspected of breaching) these Official Rules, you may be disqualified from the Competition and/or the details of your participation in the Competition may be removed from any register (publicly available or otherwise) associated with the Competition, in UA Sport's sole and absolute discretion.
- 1.8. No responsibility is assumed by us or our affiliates for any printing, typographical, mechanical or other error in these Official Rules, any online or other advertisements relating to the Competition, the announcement of any winner or prize, or otherwise in any materials related to the Competition.
- 1.9. If there is any ambiguity or inconsistency in any of the provisions in these Official Rules, UA Sports shall be the sole authority to interpret them. In the event of any inconsistency between these Official Rules and any materials relating to the Competition, these Official Rules shall prevail.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. Subject to paragraph 2.2 below, the Competition is open to individuals who are:
 - 2.1.1. legal residents of and physically located in the country where the Competition is held (*e.g. only a resident of Malaysia can participate in the Malaysian leg of the Competition*);
 - 2.1.2. 18 years of age and older or the age of majority in their jurisdiction of residence if higher than age 18, at the time of registration; and
 - 2.1.3. able and willing to comply with prevailing COVID-19 safe management requirements as may be imposed by the authorities in your jurisdiction (e.g. vaccination requirement for large events).
- 2.2. Persons in the following categories are not eligible to participate in the Competition:-
 - 2.2.1. employees of UA Sports or any of UA Sports' direct or indirect affiliate, parent company and/or subsidiary, members of each of their immediate family (including their spouse, parent, child, sibling, grandparent and/or "step" family) and individuals living in the same household of each such employee; and
 - 2.2.2. vendors, partners or any other individuals directly involved or connected to the Competition (including event organisers, media agencies and creative agencies), and their immediate family members.

The restriction under this paragraph 2.2 shall not apply to existing Under Armour brand ambassadors and Under Armour sponsored athletes.

- 2.3. **IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO OR THINK / OBSERVE THAT YOU ARE UNABLE TO SAFELY COMPLETE ANY LEVEL OF PHYSICAL ACTIVITY OR PERFORM ANY ACTIVITY OF THE CHARACTER REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COMPETITION, YOU MUST NOT DO SO. YOU UNDERSTAND AND AGREE THAT UA SPORTS MAY REFUSE TO ALLOW YOU TO PARTICIPATE OR CONTINUE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COMPETITION IF, IN THE REASONABLE OF UA SPORTS, IT IS NECESSARY FOR YOUR SAFETY OR THE SAFETY OF OTHER INDIVIDUALS.**

YOU ARE ADVISED TO CONSULT YOUR PHYSICIAN AND/OR OTHER MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS TO ASSESS AND DETERMINE YOUR ABILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES SUCH AS THOSE REQUIRED IN THE COMPETITION, AND YOU SHALL SEEK AND OBTAIN ALL NECESSARY MEDICAL ADVICE, RECOMMENDATIONS

AND/OR CLEARANCES PRIOR TO REGISTERING FOR THE COMPETITION. BY PARTICIPATING IN THE COMPETITION, YOU AGREE THAT YOU ARE VOLUNTARILY PERFORMING ANY AND ALL ACTIVITIES AND THAT ONLY YOU ARE SOLELY AND ENTIRELY RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR HEALTH AND WELL BEING (INCLUDING MENTAL HEALTH AND WELL BEING) IN THE COURSE OF YOUR PARTICIPATION. YOU MUST PERFORM ALL RACES AND ANY ASSOCIATED ACTIVITIES IN THE COMPETITION IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPLICABLE NATIONAL, STATE, AND LOCAL HEALTH PRECAUTIONS INCLUDING ANY RULES, RESTRICTIONS, REGULATIONS AND PRECAUTIONS IN RELATION TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

3. REGISTRATION FOR THE COMPETITION

3.1. To enter and register for the Competition, you must complete **all** of the following steps:

- 3.1.1. Visit www.uacombineasia.com (the “**Website**”) to register for the Competition.
- 3.1.2. The dates, locations, and travel information for the Competition in each country will be published on the Website, you must choose the country and venue of the Competition that you are eligible for. We shall not be liable or responsible for providing transportation to the venues of the Competition and shall bear no cost or expense in relation to such transportation.
- 3.1.3. You will be required to acknowledge and sign a License of Portrait Right & Release from Liability and Assumption of Risk form;
- 3.1.4. If you will be participating in the Competition as part of a team (see paragraphs 3.6 to 3.8 below), you must indicate as such and provide the necessary information; and
- 3.1.5. You must make payment of the relevant registration fee (“**Registration Fee**”) as set out below:

3.2. Your access to and use of the Website shall be subject to our website Terms and Conditions of use located at <https://account.underarmour.com/terms-and-conditions>, which is incorporated by reference herein and made a part of these Official Rules.

3.3. Your registration will be confirmed, valid and complete only upon:

- 3.3.1. our receipt of your payment of the Registration fee; and
- 3.3.2. issuance of a confirmation email by UA Sports.

3.4. All registrations are strictly non-transferrable. We assume no responsibility for any registration applications that are lost, mis-delivered, incorrect or incomplete. We reserve the right to refuse or reject your application to register for the Competition any anytime for any reason whatsoever, including without limitation limit on capacity or safety considerations.

3.5. If you wish to update your contact information or any other information submitted as part of your registration in the Competition, you may contact us at support@uacombineasia.com.

Team registration

3.6. You may form teams to compete in the Competition, and each team must be made up of four (4) participants competing in the same country and each participant must also register for the Competition on an individual basis as set out in paragraph 3.1 (“**Team**”).

3.7. If you wish to form a Team, you must indicate as such and provide the name of your Team and the full names of each of your fellow Team members when you check-in onsite 30 minutes prior to the start of competition.

- 3.8. Following the Team registration, any substitution or replacement of Team member(s) will not be permitted. Subject to any exceptions that may be made at UA Sport's sole and absolute discretion, if any member of a Team:

- 3.8.1. withdraws from the Competition;
- 3.8.2. fails to show at the Competition; or
- 3.8.3. is disqualified from the Competition for any reason,

the Team will automatically be disqualified. Notwithstanding the foregoing, each remaining Team member may, subject to UA's discretion, continue to participate in the Competition in the Individual categories by converting the Team registration into individual registrations.

Deemed disqualification

- 3.9. Any entries in the Competition registered using macro, robotic, script or other forms of automatic registration or application will be immediately and automatically deemed disqualified, and any Registration Fee(s) paid or part thereof in connection with the foregoing will not be refunded.

Registration Fee

- 3.10. Payment of the Registration Fee shall be made in accordance with the instructions and in the manner and form as set out on the Website.
- 3.11. You shall be entitled to a refund of the Registration Fee only in the following circumstances:-
- 3.11.1. if you withdraw your registration for the Competition at least one (1) week prior to the commencement of the Competition in your applicable country, you are entitled to the full refund of your Registration Fee;
 - 3.11.2. if you withdraw your registration for the Competition within one (1) week of the commencement of the Competition in the applicable country, UA Sports shall have the sole and absolute discretion to determine if you are entitled to a refund; and
 - 3.11.3. if you do not show at the Competition, you shall not be entitled to any refund of the Registration Fee of part thereof.
- 3.12. Where you are entitled to any refund under these Official Rules, such refund will be made in such manner as we may stipulate from time to time, subject to your provision of all relevant information and documentation as we may require to process the refund.

4. VERIFICATION OF IDENTIFICATION

- 4.1. Upon your arrival at the Competition venue at the designated location, date and time applicable to your registration, you will:
- 4.1.1. be required to check in by providing the staff located at the Competition venue with a valid and generally accepted form of photographic identification, such as your NRIC, FIN, driver's license, or passport in order for us to verify your identity and registration; and
 - 4.1.2. you will receive a pack containing Under Armour gear which you will be required to wear during the Competition. The pack includes one (1) top, one (1) shorts, one (1) pair of socks and one (1) pair of shoes, all in the sizes specified by you during the online entry and registration process ("**Competition Pack**").
- 4.2. If you are unable to prove to the reasonable satisfaction of UA Sports and/or the staff at the Competition venue that you are a valid, registered and qualified participant in the Competition, you will be deemed ineligible to participate in the Competition.
- 4.3. The Competition Pack and its contents are not replaceable, exchangeable or redeemable for cash or in-kind. We shall not be responsible for any Competition Pack or part thereof that is

stolen, lost or misplaced by you. Any request for exchange of sizes in relation to any content of the Competition Pack will be subject to availability.

- 4.4. The Competition Pack is provided by us on an “as is” and “as available” basis, and to the maximum extent permitted under applicable law, we disclaim all warranties (whether express or implied) including but not limited to warranties that the Competition Pack and its contents will meet your requirements, warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.

5. COMPETITION RULES AND PRECAUTIONS

- 5.1. The Competition’s key features are as follow:-:

- 5.1.1. you can compete in either the individual or Team categories:
 5.1.1.1. for the individual categories, the Competition is divided into men’s division and women’s division; and
 5.1.1.2. for the Team categories, you may compete in a mixed Team (i.e. both men and women can participate in a single Team);
 5.1.2. in each division there are EIGHT (8) physical tests;
 5.1.3. You and/or your Team can choose to compete in all 8 tests or selected tests of your choosing; and
 5.1.4. The details for each of the tests and the relevant rules including judging criteria, injury policy and appeal process can be found at www.uacombineasia.com (“**Competition Rules**”).

- 5.2. You represent and warrant to us that:

- 5.2.1. prior to your participation in Competition and each of the tests, you have carefully read and understood the Competition Rules, and are fully aware of the potential risk of your participation in the Competition;
 5.2.2. you have no illness, injury or medical condition that would prevent or interfere with your or any other party’s safe participation in the Competition; and
 5.2.3. you have not knowingly used, taken or are taking whether before or during the course of the Competition, any prohibited drugs or substances whether for performance-enhancing purposes or otherwise (including but not limited to the Banned Substance List of the World Anti-Doping Agency, which is accessible: https://www.wada-ama.org/sites/default/files/2022-01/2022list_final_en_0.pdf).

Scoring and awarding of points

- 5.3. Each test will be judged and scored according to your performance, and you will be ranked according to your scores. Points are awarded based on your rank obtained in each test. You may find the scoring of each test and points awarding instructions and rules at www.uacombineasia.com.
- 5.4. Our decisions on all matters relating to the Competition (including without limitation the judging and scoring of participants’ performance in the tests) shall be final and binding on you and we will not entertain any correspondence or appeal relating to such decisions.

- 6.2. In the unlikely event of a tie in the total points awarded, the individual or Team with the higher average score across all tests will be the winner.
- 6.3. The official list of winners (including each of the winners' first name, last initial and city/state/province) will be made available at www.uacombineasia.com.
- 6.4. All notices or communications given by us to you will be deemed to be received or notified to you:

- 6.4.1. on the following day of posting if via your last known address; and
- 6.4.2. on the date of broadcast if via electronic media such as SMSes and e-mails.
- 6.5. In order to claim his or her Prize(s), it is the sole responsibility of each winner to present clear and valid identification, when requested by UA Sports.
- 6.6. The winners will be notified in-person on the day of the event and by email. We reserve the right to disqualify a Prize winner and forfeit any Prize if:-
 - 6.6.1. any Prize(s) are unclaimed after [ten (10) calendar days] from the date on which the notification is sent to the winner;
 - 6.6.2. we are unable to contact the Prize winner(s);
 - 6.6.3. the Prize winner(s) does not respond to us, or notifies us that he or she does not wish to claim the Prize(s);
 - 6.6.4. the Prize winner(s) has committed any act of fraud or dishonesty, or has misrepresented anything in connection with this Competition;
 - 6.6.5. the Prize winner(s) does not agree to abide by and be bound by these Official Rules;
or
 - 6.6.6. the Prize winner(s) dies or becomes mentally incapacitated.
- 6.7. If a Prize winner(s) is disqualified, we may in our sole and absolute discretion select another winner to replace the disqualified Prize winner(s).
- 6.8. Non-compliance with or breach of any of these Official Rules may disqualify you from the Competition, and any Prizes won may be forfeited, withheld, withdrawn or reclaimed by us.

7. SPECIFIC TERMS AND CONDITIONS ASSOCIATED WITH THE PRIZES

We reserve the right to substitute any Prize with a prize of equal or greater value in the event an advertised prize becomes unavailable, and to award fewer than the above-stated number of Prizes in any category if an insufficient number of eligible participants or winners are available. - 7.3. All Prizes are provided on an "as is" and "as available" basis, and we make no warranty, representation, guarantee or undertaking of any kind with respect to the Prizes. To the maximum extent permitted under applicable law, we disclaim all warranties (whether express or implied) in relation to the Prizes.

8. LIABILITY

- 8.1. To the maximum extent permitted under applicable law, you hereby agree that UA Sports and those involved in the development, organization, operation, production, implementation and distribution of the Competition, including UA Sports' respective parent companies, affiliates, subsidiaries, service providers, and agencies, and each of their respective directors, officers, agents, employees, attorneys, and any other person or entity associated with such entities and/or the Competition shall not be liable for any and all claims, damages, losses or injuries of any kind whatsoever, including any third party claims, damages, losses or injuries, or any injury, loss or damages of any kind to persons, including death, or property, arising from or relating to, in whole or in part, directly, or indirectly, the Competition, including entry, registration and participation in the Competition, any prize of the Competition or prize-related activity (including without limitation, acceptance, possession, use or misuse of any prize).

9. INTERNET ORIENTED CONDITIONS

- 9.1. No responsibility is assumed for electronic transmission errors for reasons beyond our reasonable control resulting in omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operations or transmission, communication line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to or alterations of entry materials (including the online registration form), or for technical, network, server, provider, telephone equipment, electronic, computer, hardware or software malfunctions or limitations of any kind including any injury or damage to your or any other person's computer or device related to or resulting from participation in, access or download of any materials with respect to the Competition, or inaccurate transmissions of or failure to receive any entry or registration application or information on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at the Website or any combination thereof.
- 9.2. If for any reason beyond our reasonable control, the Internet portion of the Competition (including the Website) is not capable of running as planned, including infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, human error, or any other causes which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of this Competition (including the Website), we reserve the right at its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition and to select all winners from the eligible entries or registrations received that are unaffected by the problem. We further reserve the right, at our sole and absolute discretion, to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry or registration processor undermines the integrity of the Competition (including the Website).
- 9.3. We may, at our sole and absolute discretion, prohibit you from participating in the Competition if we determine that you are attempting to undermine the legitimate operation of the Competition by cheating, hacking, deception or other unfair practices or abusing, threatening, harassing or intending to abuse, threaten or harass other participants or staff or representatives of UA Sports or any person or entity involved in the development, organization, operation, production, implementation and distribution of the Competition.
- 9.4. Any attempt by you to deliberately damage the Website or undermine the legitimate operation of the Competition may be a violation of applicable law and we reserve the right to seek or claim damages from you to the fullest extent allowed under applicable law.

10. DISPUTES AND ARBITRATION

- 10.1. To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, you agree that any dispute resolution proceedings arising from or in connection with the Competition (including your participation in the Competition) will be conducted only on an individual basis and not in a class, consolidated or representative action.
- 10.2. To the maximum extent permitted under applicable law, any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with the Competition, including questions regarding the validity of the terms in these Official Rules and the Competition Rules, shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration administered by the Singapore International Arbitration Centre ("**SIAC**") in accordance with the Arbitration Rules of the SIAC for the time being in force, which rules are deemed to be incorporated by reference herein. The seat of arbitration shall be Singapore. The tribunal shall consist of one (1) arbitrator and the language of arbitration shall be English. You and us hereby agree that in the event of any arbitration pursuant to this paragraph 10, the arbitration venue and location shall be Singapore (unless the Parties agree otherwise). Any decision and/or awards of the arbitration tribunal shall be final and binding on you and us, and may be used (without limitation) as a basis for judgment in any country which has ratified the 1958 New York Convention on the Recognition and Enforcement of Foreign Arbitral Awards. In the event that recourse to the courts shall be necessary for the purpose of determining any question of law required to be determined for arbitration, you and us agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Singapore, agree not to commence any suit, action or proceeding relating thereto except in such courts, and waive, to the fullest extent permitted by law, the right to move to dismiss or transfer any action brought in such courts on the basis of

any objection to personal jurisdiction or venue. This arbitral agreement is governed by the laws of the Republic of Singapore.

- 10.3. To the maximum extent permitted under applicable law, you further agree that any claim arising out of or in connection with the Competition (including your participation in the Competition) must be filed within one (1) year from the date on which such claim arises or it is forever barred.
